



Welcome to the Curran Apple Orchard Park!

<u>History</u>: Mary and Charles Curran purchased a 7.33 acre parcel of land in 1951 and transformed it into an apple orchard with 250 Gravenstein, McIntosh and Golden Delicious apple trees. In 1993, the University Place Community Council successfully obtained Conservation Futures funds from Pierce County to preserve the orchard forever as a park. **CORE** (Curran Orchard Resource Enthusiasts) volunteers continue to work with the City to maintain the orchard as an "urban, edible" outdoor classroom.

<u>Tours</u>: On site and self-guided tours are available along with interpretative displays. For tour information, please visit <u>www.curranappleorchard.com</u>.

<u>Adopt-A-Tree Program</u>: The Adopt-A-Tree Program offers a unique opportunity for people to adopt and nurture their own apple tree through an entire growing season. It's a great opportunity for individuals, friends and families to work on a project together. Adoptions are good for one harvest season (Jan-Oct. 15). Benefits include delicious apples, your name on a tree tag and the opportunity to participate in a Cider Squeeze. All adopters are responsible for taping and hanging "Do Not Pick" signs on their trees if desired. Due to weather and other conditions, we cannot guarantee harvest volumes.

<u>Adoption Types</u>: There are two types of adoptions: **1) Pruning Adoptions** and **2) Orchard Supporter/Gift Adoptions**. (All fees help support orchard activities).

<u>Pruning Adoptions</u>: (\$65 available January through March 31) Adopters are required to prune, thin fruit, weed, tape and sign their tree, harvest, and clean up windfalls. (Approximately 4-6 visits per year). Free pruning instruction is available in person or on our website.

<u>Orchard Supporter/Gift Adoptions</u>: (\$125 available January through July 31) are a perfect choice for people who want a tree but cannot prune. Adopters are required to thin fruit, weed, tape and sign their tree, harvest, and clean up windfalls.

Be a "Good Apple": Want to support the orchard without having a tree? All donations are greatly appreciated! You can also add an additional donation amount to your adoption.

CORE volunteers help maintain the orchard along with sponsoring various activities throughout the year. Volunteers ALWAYS needed!
