Mulch is available, with more expected on the 21st after contracted pruning is finished.

Tree Tags

Tree Tags: Barry and Rich are reworking the placement of adopter name tags. The posts in the ground that held adopter names rotted so moving to lower branches and trunks of trees for this year. They are going to use Heavy duty zip ties to adhere the sign this year. Debbie mentioned a High School student contacted us needing hours before the 20th with any assistant we might need. Debbie suggested if help is needed to reach out to the student.

Kiosk Updates

Kiosk Updates: Rich is working on getting the adopter names with assigned tree on weekly basis. It is hard to do in the rain but working on it. There are 3 sheets . Last year we had 5 sheets by the end of the season.

Pruning Activities

- **Pruning Banner:** Sue has all the updates at the printer
- Family Tree Care schedule: January 21 (gates open)-They can contact Tony or Jackson if there is a weather delay.
- Pruning Parties: January 31, February 7 and 21, March 7, 21, and 28. Kayla Stewart will send an email to let Adopters know if they if there are dry days they can start pruning prior to the 31st. Debbie pruned one of her trees placing what she trimmed on the tarp.
- Pruning Adoption Verification System?
- Lists of "to be pruned" trees- One is Adopter to prune status and volunteer pruning list. When an adopter completes prunes their tree, they need to sign that their tree is done on the adopter pruning list. Adopters /Volunteers can prune other trees on the Volunteer pruning list. The trees on the list are prioritized. Trees marked with number 1 next to the tree are to be pruned first. When that tree is pruned the volunteer pruner needs to sign off that the pruning is done. We needed a better way to keep track of the tree pruning.
